<b>Sancerre 'Le Chêne du Roy', Domaine Pierre Girault   France</b> Bright and crisp, with intense flavours of citrus and green figs, a rich texture, and a streak of minerality on the finish.			£36.50

<b>Viognier, French Ambush   France</b> A stylish, chic wine with intense notes of white flowers and fresh pineapple, tempered by a ripe peach roundness.	£3.80	£5.35	£23.50
<b>Garnatxa Blanca, Herència Altés   Spain</b> From the top producer in up-and-coming region Terra Alta, this is a stunning example of what Spain can do with Grenache. Textured and aromatic, the wine exudes notes of white peach, melon and lemon zest. A refreshing salinity adds a satisfying edge to the lengthy finish.	£4.25	£6.05	£25.50
<b>Riesling, Hartenberg   South Africa</b> Riesling is known as 'The Queen of Grapes' for a reason: great examples of this variety are complex, elegant, and can last decades. Hartenberg's version is deliciously aromatic and textured, with a fruit-forward nose and vibrant acidity.			£26.50
<b>Chardonnay, Stone Barn   USA</b> A fresh and approachable style of Chardonnay from Monterey which sees minimal oak. Tropical notes of mango and papaya are present on the palate. Will pair nicely with white meats.			£25.00
<b>Chenin Blanc 'O.V.N.I.', Jérémie Mourat   France</b> This wine defies appellation rules, hence taking the name O.V.N.I, the French for U.F.O. Subtle notes of exotic fruits are present on the nose, while passionfruit, melon, citrus and peach come through on the palate. Pair with seafood dishes, salads and poultry.			£30.00
<b>Langhe Chardonnay 'Bujet', Franco Conterno   Italy</b> A complex Chardonnay from Piedmont. Ripe apple and preserved lemon are held together with a refreshing salinity, while notes of peach and mango add a richness with a subtle hint of nutmeg.			£35.00

### Rioja Tinto 'Qvinto Arrio', Bodegas Navarrsotillo | Spain

This is a young, modern style of Rioja. On the nose, spicy clove and vanilla notes accompany red cherry fruit. It is well-balanced with good body and a lengthy finish and will pair beautifully with cured meats and cheeses or roast lamb. Organic and vegan-friendly.
